It's the plan that:

- Sets direction, budget and work plans
- Connects delivery to community outcomes
- Defines the levels of funding required

Promotes a better Rotorua for all



Guiding principles

- **Grounded in the present:** understanding of the present, our organisation, our financial position, our direction, our assets (condition and performance)
- Outward focused: influences, challenges, drivers from the world around us (demographic, economic, environmental and social/cultural factors)
- Presents the right debate: a debate with the community that focuses on the balance between the community's needs and aspirations, service realities and the community's willingness to pay
- **Tells one integrated story:** a single overall story, all components should support and line-up with overall direction.
- Long-term planning means long-term: not just the three year review









- Maintaining appropriate debt headroom to respond to future opportunities or challenges




The financial strategy and other financial statements presented are underpinned by the following **key elements**:

- Maintain debt below 250% of revenue




Forecasted Rates Increase:
