ROTORUA DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

ON-LICENCE

(for premises)

Sections 14 to 16 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **DEREK ALLOMES TRADING LIMITED** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at 1151 Arawa Street, Rotorua and known as "**THE BLIND FINCH HAMBURGERIA**", for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:


- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not –
- (i) Present on the premises to dine
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
- (i) **Monday to Sunday - 9.00 am to 1.00 am the following day;**
- (ii) **Except that on the Thursday before Good Friday; and on Easter Saturday; and on Christmas Eve; and on the day before Anzac Day, alcohol may only be sold between 8.00 am and 12.00 midnight.**
- (c) The following steps must be taken to promote the responsible consumption of alcohol:
"Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are open for the sale of alcohol in accordance with the menu submitted with the application for the licence, or variations of that menu of a similar range and standard".
- (d) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
"The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons."
- (e) The whole of the premises from **10.00pm until closing** is designated as a **Supervised Area**

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Either
- (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
- (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
