Criteria for Temporary Ban

- There is evidence an area has experienced a **high level of crime or disorder** that can be shown to have been **caused or made worse by alcohol consumption** in the area
- Is appropriate and proportionate in the light of the experience
- Can be justified as a reasonable limitation on people's rights and freedoms

- 4. That Council resolves to introduce a Temporary Alcohol Ban Area for the Marist St Michael's Sports Park Reserve, for a period of 12 months, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**
- 5. That Council resolves to introduce a Temporary Alcohol Ban Area for Lots 2 DPS 65170, Lot 3 DPS 65170, Lot 4 DPS 65170 and Lot 5 DPS 65170 for a period of 12 months, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**
