


# SPEED LIMIT REVIEW 2021

- Speed limits are set under Council's Speed Limit Bylaw, in accordance with the Land Transport Rule "Setting of Speed Limits 2017"
- Council reviews speed limits on local roads every 3 years to ensure consistency in our region and across adjoining road networks
- Under the Rule, Council must consult with those that may be affected by a proposed speed limit

# SPEED LIMIT REVIEW PROCESS

- Jun 20 • Formal Speed Limit Review (WSP Opus)
  - 11 Feb 21 • Officers speed limit recommendations presented to Strategy, Policy & Finance Committee
  - 25 Feb 21 • S,P&F recommendation to Council
  - Mar 21 • Public consultation on proposed speed limit changes

# MAIN CHANGES

- Waka Kotahi – NZTA phasing out all 70km/h speed limits
- Response to requests/submissions from residents
- Formalising speed limits not previously gazetted
- Rural Road Safety Review, incl. variable speed limits outside schools

# CONSULTATION

- Council must consult with local communities considered affected by existing or proposed speed limit and major stakeholders identified in the Land Transport Rule (e.g. Waka Kotahi, TA's, Police, AA)
- Consultation to include:
  - Letters to major stakeholders
  - Newspaper Public Notice
  - Korero mai interactive mapping
