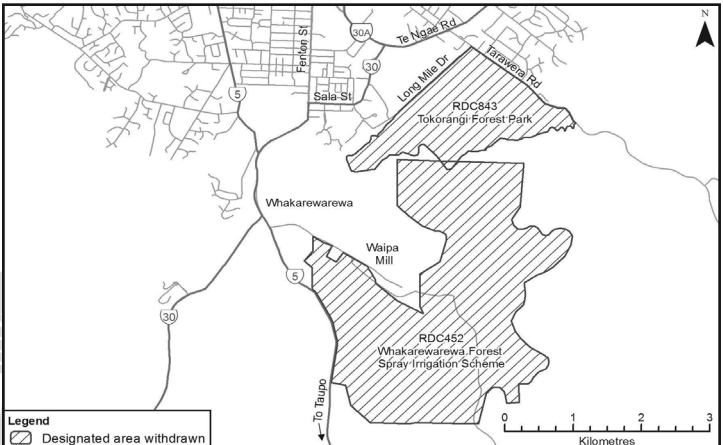
NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF TWO REQUIREMENTS FOR DESIGNATION: TOKORANGI FOREST PARK (Designation number RDC843) AND WHAKAREWAREWA STATE FOREST SPRAY IRRIGATION SCHEME (Designation number RDC452)

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 168(4) AND 168(5) OF THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT ACT 1991 AND CLAUSE 4(9) OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE ACT

Rotorua District Council gives notice that on 19 December 2012 the Council resolved, as requiring authority, to withdraw the following requirements for designation from the Proposed Rotorua District Plan:

- (a) A requirement for a designation relating to the Tokorangi Forest Park (Designation number RDC843); and
- (b) A requirement for a designation relating to the Whakarewarewa State Forest Spray Irrigation Scheme (Designation number RDC452).

Council originally decided to designate all its assets and included the above requirements for designation in the Proposed Rotorua District Plan that was notified on 31 October 2012. Details of the designations can be found in Appendix 6 of the Proposed Rotorua District Plan. The extent of the requirements for designation to be withdrawn is illustrated below:



The requirements will be removed from the existing text and planning maps of the Proposed Rotorua District Plan no later than 18 January 2013 pursuant to clause 4(10) of the First Schedule to the Act. Proposed Rotorua District Plan update subscribers will receive amended text and planning maps in the next update.
