| Batteries (smaller sized) | | Recycle (other – not kerbside) | Bunnings stores, battery collection boxes | Tape over the top of your battery before depositing for recycling to minimise fire risk from remaining charge. Avoid stock piling batteries and do not put these into your yellow lid bin |
