The Total Mobility Scheme is a national scheme and in Rotorua is administered by the Bay of Plenty Regional Council. If eligible, registered users are entitled to a 50% discount on taxi fares.

The Mobility Parking Scheme provides specific parking spaces and parking privileges for people who hold a CCS Disability Action (CCSDA) parking permit.

## Did you know?

- Only people displaying a current permit may use mobility parks. Parking enforcement officers will issue a \$150 infringement notice to anyone using a mobility park without a permit.
- Mobility parking permit holders can use dedicated mobility spaces for as long as they want without paying. All other car parks can be used by permit holders, without having to pay, for double the amount of time specified (except P15 spaces). If no time limit is specified, permit holders may park for as long as required without having to pay. Ensure your valid mobility parking permit is clearly displayed.
- You may use your CCSDA permit all over New Zealand.
- The permit holder does not have to be the driver, but must be a passenger in the vehicle.

# asked questions

- What is different about mobility parking spaces? Mobility parking spaces are wider than regular parks. Wider parks make it easier to get in and out of
- If there are no mobility parks free, what do I do? You can park in a regular park, and providing your CCSDA permit is displayed there are special privileges.
- How can I apply for a CCSDA mobility permit?

- Is there anywhere where I can't park? The car park still has to be a legal car park (for example, not a loading zone or dotted yellow lines). There are no privileges for P5, P10 or P15 parks.
- I am visiting Rotorua and I have an overseas mobility parking permit, can I use it in Rotorua? Yes, providing it is current and on display.
- Can I lend my permit to a friend of family member?

No. If you lend someone else your permit and you are not present (even if they have a disability) CCSDA may revoke your membership and cancel your permit.
