These are the only Rotorua reserves designated for camping/overnight stays. Staying overnight on any other public reserve is prohibited under the Reserves Act. Please be aware that security patrols do monitor such public spaces.

Campervans are welcome to park in metred spaces in the Rotorua Town Centre, as long as they fit completely within the lines that define the space.

LIQUOR BAN AREA

Alcohol cannot be openly consumed in the Central Business District, or in the city's parks and reserves. This ban is enforced by the Police.

OVERNIGHT PARKING

Council recommends staying overnight in holiday parks and designated campsites. Limited overnight parking is available for certified self-contained vehicles only at the lake end of Hinemoa Street. People using this parking area must display a self-contained sticker on their vehicle to avoid being moved on by security staff.

SEWAGE AND WASTEWATER

Motorhome and campervan wastewater tanks and cassettes can be emptied for free 24 hours a day at the Wastewater Treatment Plant on Te Ngae Road, between Fenton and Sala Streets. All holiday parks also have wastewater dump stations available for guest use.

RECYCLING

Recyclable materials can be disposed of for free Monday to Saturday, 9am - 4.30pm and Sunday, 9.30am - 4pm at the Rotorua Recycling Centre, 20 Te Ngae Road. Holiday parks also provide on-site recycling facilities for guest use.

RUBBISH

Rubbish can be disposed of at the Rotorua Landfill on State Highway 30, or the Rotorua Transfer Station on the corner of Te Ngae Road and Hamiora Place.
