### Background

Portable toilet waste is produced by Domestic and International passengers aircraft, boats, trains, caravans, camper vans, buses, portaloo's etc.

This type of waste is much stronger and thicker than ordinary sewage and is more than likely to have various treatment chemicals with it to stabilise it. It is not ordinary sewage and requires special conditions for acceptance for treatment and disposal into Council's Sewerage System.

## Disposal

Council has provided a special place for the disposal of these wastes. It is situated by council's Waste water treatment plant gate, off Te-Ngae Road.

Van, bus and boat operators may use the camper van discharge point located here to get rid of their sewage wastes for free.

Also located here is council's Trade waste station for the disposal other types of portable sewage, but you need to get approval off council's Trade Waste Officer to use it (the Station).

## Accepting Portable Sewage Waste from Others

Holiday Parks, Marinas, Airports, and many other similar Businesses, wishing to discharge these types of wastes into Councils Sewerage System need to make a Trade Waste Consent Application and provide facilities such as described by Council's drawing no. 12796 for Portable Wastewater Disposal units.
